

If You Purchased a Lawn Mower with a Gas Engine up to 30 Horsepower You Could Receive Benefits from Class Action Settlements

There are multiple Settlements in a class action concerning gasoline-powered lawn mowers. The lawsuit claims that the Defendants misrepresented and overstated the horsepower of their lawn mowers and lawn mower engines. **The lawsuit does not concern the safety of the lawn mowers.** The Defendants deny these claims and deny they did anything wrong. All of the parties have agreed to settle.

Who's Included? You are included if you purchased a lawn mower containing a gas combustible engine up to 30 horsepower for your own use (and not for resale) between January 1, 1994 and April 12, 2010. Either the lawn mower or the engine of the lawn mower must have been manufactured or sold by a Defendant.

What Can You Get? The type of benefits you are eligible to receive depends on the specific lawn mower(s) you purchased. The Settlements provide a variety of benefits, including cash payments (up to \$35 for a walk-behind mower/ up to \$75 for a riding mower), an agreement by certain Defendants to extend warranty benefits and/or to use a new "Certified Power Rating" standard. If claims exceed the amount available for cash payments, payments will be reduced.

How to Get Benefits? You will need to submit a Claim Form to get a payment or an extended engine warranty. You can submit a Claim Form online or by mail. The first deadline to submit a Claim Form is **August 31, 2010**.

Your Other Rights. If you do not want to be legally bound by a Settlement, you must exclude yourself from that Settlement. The deadline to exclude yourself from any or all of the Settlements is **June 4, 2010**. If you stay in a Settlement you will not be able to sue that settling Defendant(s) for any claim relating to that Settlement. If you stay in a Settlement, you may object to that Settlement by **June 4, 2010**. The Court will hold a hearing on **June 22, 2010** to consider whether to approve the Settlements and a request for attorneys' fees. The Court has appointed attorneys to represent the Class. You may hire your own attorney at your own expense.
